


- founded in 1967 as a branch of the Rimsky-Korsakov St. Petersburg Conservatory
- in 1991 became an independent music institute named after the famous Russian composer Alexander Glazunov



- located in the city of Petrozavodsk, the capital of the Republic of Karelia



- situated in the northwest of Russia
 - 1000 km away from Moscow
 - 400 km away from St. Petersburg
 - shares a common border with Finland






Karelia is the land of forests and lakes.

Mountain park Ruskeala, the Valaam monastery.








The Petrozavodsk State Glazunov Conservatoire

- is in the top 10 best higher education music institutions in Russia
- holds key positions in artistic, scientific, pedagogic and educational work in the north-west of Russia



- 500-600 students study at the Petrozavodsk conservatoire
- around 100 of them (15%) are foreign students mostly from China
- 1/5 of all students become laureates of international and all-Russian competitions annually



The Petrozavodsk Conservatoire is a 6-storeyed building with a Concert Hall, a Rehearsal Hall, an Opera Studio, a Research Library and a Gym:

• equipped with the newest sound and lightning equipment






- the 60-seat **Recital Hall** with two grand pianos and Johannus electronic organ




- the 40-seat Opera Studio for solo performances and chamber music concerts, rehearsals, exams and master-classes



The Research Library

- has a 40-seat reading hall
- holds approximately 75,000 scores and parts, books about music, subscriptions to music periodicals
